27th June – Feast of Our Lady of Unfailing Help (Our Lady of Perpetual Succour) when the Diocese of Leeds was created in 1878 Our Lady of Unfailing Help was declared the principal patroness. Under this title Our Lady is represented as a 15th Century Byzantine icon. The Memorare is a prayer to help us call on Mary, Mother of Christ, for help.



29th June – feast of Saints Peter and Paul - two leading saints of the early church. It is a feast in honour of their martyrdom in Rome.



30th June - First Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church. These are the Christians who died with St Peter in the first great Roman persecution under the Emperor Nero in 67AD



1st July – St Oliver Plunket – a Bishop and martyr. Born in Co Meath in 1625 and died at Tyburn in 1681. He was the final victim of ‘The Popish Plot’ and the last person to be executed for the faith in England.



3rd July – St Thomas the Apostle – ‘Doubting Thomas’ who lacked faith in the Resurrection, which opened the door for his profession of faith - ‘My Lord and my God’. Thomas preached in India and was martyred there.
