Interesting Facts – Keith Cooper, as a young boy, saw the head of St Oliver Plunkett (Blessed at the time) in Drogheda on a school trip to Ireland. Cath Cooper saw the hand of Margaret Clitherow on a Brownie trip to the Bar Convent in York.



5th July – St Anthony Zaccaria – born in Lombardy in 1502 and studied medicine at Padua before becoming a priest. He founded the Congregation of Clerics of St Paul, known as the Barnabites, which worked for the reform of morals among the faithful. He died in 1539.



6th July – St Maria Goretti – born in Ancona in Italy in 1890. She spent her childhood near Nettuno in poverty, helping her mother in the domestic chores. She was a religious girl and much given to prayer. In 1902, whilst defending her chastity she was repeatedly stabbed to death.



9th July - Saints Augustine Zhao and companions – this feast celebrates 120 martyrs who died between 1648 and 1930. Augustine suffered the cruelest tortures and died in 1815.
