FEAST DAYS:

11th July – St Benedict, abbot – born in Norcia in 480. He studied in Rome and lived for some time in solitude. He founded a monastery which established the spirituality and way of life on monastic communities ever since. He died in 547.

13th July – St Henry – born in Bavaria in 973, Henry became Duke of Bavaria in 995, and was crowned Holy Roman Emperor in 1014. He was ardent for the reform of the Church, took part in synods, founded monasteries, appointed bishops of integrity. With his wife he lived a semi-monastic life of prayer and discipline.

14th July – St Camillus de Lellis, priest – born in the kingdom of Naples in 1550, he became a soldier and led a dissolute life for some years. Horrified by the misery of the sick that he saw in hospital, he devoted his life to their care. He was ordained and founded a religious congregation to establish hospitals and run them. He died in 1614.

15th July– St Bonaventure, bishop & doctor of the Church – born in 1218. He studied in Paris and became a professor there. He joined the Franciscan Order and eventually became Minister General in 1257. His writings reveal a profound spirituality. He died in 1274

16th Our Lady of Mount Carmel – Carmel was the place where Elijah proclaimed the faith of Israel in the one God. During the Crusades, Christian hermits lived in caves on the mountains and came together to form the Carmelite Order. Mount Carmel overlooks the plains of Galilee and is under the protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
