SUMMARY OF THE PARISH MEETING -30th JUNE

- As cases of Covid are on the increase again it was agreed to continue with the present arrangements.
- Our appeal for the Ukranian crisis totaled £800. It was agreed that we increase this to £1,000 which will be forwarded to CAFOD.
- We hope that we have solved the ingress of water in the kitchen area.
- The exterior fabric of the Church needs immediate attention – roof, gulley, pointing
- The windows on the ground floor are in a bad condition and need replacing. Three companies have given quotes and these have been forwarded to the Diocese. It is hoped to have the windows replaced before the bad weather sets in. Thank you to Keith Cooper for all his hard work dealing with this matter.
- It was agreed to continue with one reader at Mass.
- Communion will continue with the present arrangement.
- Offertory – we will take up the gifts but the offertory collection will remain as we enter/leave Church.
