COVID 19 UPDATE

The Priests and Deacons of the Deanery met on Tuesday to discuss the latest guidelines from the Bishops of England and Wales conference. Aware of the fact that the Covid-19 virus is still circulating in society and that places of worship should always consider the prevailing local conditions for the virus. The Bishops will not be restoring the obligation to attend Sunday Mass at this stage. As we begin to move out of the restrictions let us be mindful of others when we come to Church and attend Holy Mass. In the Halifax Deanery we will do all we can to keep you safe when you visit Church.

- *Churches will continue as before with the addition of St Albans being open and St Columba's resuming Sunday Mass. The easing of restrictions will be a gradual process.*
- *Face coverings are to be worn.*
- *Limited numbers and registering to attend Mass will continue.*
- *No sign of peace, hymn books, holy water or communion under both kinds.*
- *We can have communal singing but still wearing masks. (Priests felt that this was contradictory.)*
- *The priest will continue to wear a mask and sanitise his hands prior to distributing communion.*
- *Baptisms now have no restrictions on numbers but there will be no multiple children being baptised unless they are in the same family.*
- *Stewards will continue to be deployed at St Theresa's.*
