St Theresa's Repairs and Maintenance Update:

Over the past year or so we have had problems with water ingress in both the Church and the hall. With help from various people and the Leeds Diocese building department, we have come up with a plan. The Church and the hall were recently inspected and a list of repairs drawn up of what needed doing. A roofing company will carry out maintenance and repairs to the fabric of the Church and the presbytery starting in mid August and lasting a couple of weeks. Almost at the same time a painter will carry out work to the exterior of the Church and presbytery. The replacement of the hall windows with PVC is on going but we hope to have some news shortly and have the job finished before the winter. A small amount of remedial painting will need to be done inside the Church once the work is completed. It is important that we look after the fabric of the buildings in our Parish. K.C.
