The website will require only your name and email address.

This will enable us to observe the government regulations which ask that we keep a record for 21 days to assist with 'Test and Trace.'

The New Normal:



Due to the size of St Theresa's Church we will follow a system of first in last out. The stewards will guide you to your place and will indicate when you can leave. The 2 metre social distancing will be observed and we are asked to avoid gathering with others inside or in the vicinity of the Church. Please remain seated during Mass. **Face masks will be compulsory from Saturday 8th August.**

Readers must sanitise before and after reading or wear single use gloves. They should avoid touching the microphone or Lectionary apart from page turning. They may remove their face mask to read.
