Saints of the week:

23rd August – St Rose of Lima – born to a Spanish family in Lima in 1586. Rose entered the Third Order of St Dominic. She died in 1617 aged 31.

24th August – St Bartholomew, Apostle – Born in Cana, Galilee, one of the twelve apostles. He is probably to be identified with Nathaniel, whom Philip called to follow Jesus. Tradition says he preached the gospel in India and was martyred there.

25th August- St Louis – born in 1214. He Became King Louis 1X of France in 1236. He undertook Crusades to the Holy Land and was famed for humility and love of the Church. He died in Carthage in 1270.

25th August - Saint Joseph Calasanz was born to a wealthy family in Aragon, Spain in 1557. He died in 1648.

26th August – Blessed Dominic of the Mother of God - born near Viterbo in Italy in 1792 and died in Reading in 1849. He came to England to work in the conversion of the country
