Saints of the week:



28th August – St Augustine – born at Thagaste in North Africa in 354. He was converted by the prayers of his mother and baptised by St Ambrose, Bishop of Milan, in 387. He became Bishop of Hippo.



30th August – Ss Margaret Clitheroe, Anne Line and Margaret Ward –Martyrs – all three are remembered for their resourcefulness, their loyalty, their outstanding courage and for the service they rendered the Church during dangerous times in aiding the ministry of priests.



31st August – St Aidan, Bishop and the Saints of Lindisfarne - with St Aidan are also remembered all those holy abbots , bishops, teachers and missionaries who made Lindisfarne a cradle of English Christianity.



3rd September – St Gregory the Great, Pope and Doctor of the Church – born about 540 was Prefect of Rome when he renounced the world and entered a monastery about 575. He founded monasteries in Rome and in Scicily. He became Pope in 590. His writings are extensive, particularly the commentaries on scripture. His liturgies, collected in the Gregorian Sacramentary, have been influential to our own day.



4th September – St Cuthbert, Bishop – was born about 634 and died on Farne on 20th March 687. After the Synod of Whitby in 664 he became prior of Lindisfarne. In 676 he left the monastery to live in solitude on the island of Inner Farne.
