## REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE TO ST. THERESA'S

What started off as a small area of damp carpet in the kitchen area of the hall last winter grew into a major expense for the parish this September. Over the last seven months a great deal of work has been done to the Church and presbytery, some of which was aimed at solving the damp problem. The outside of the Church and presbytery have been painted – we are still waiting to have UPVC double glazing fitted to the hall windows. Meanwhile, the roof of the Church and the presbytery have been repaired as well as the front wall of the Church. Eight areas inside the Church, where damp had penetrated, have also been repaired and decorated. All the repair work has now been completed and we are grateful to Ben Woolley (Painter & Decorator), Colin Thompson (C & M Roofing) Matthew Kitchen and James Martin (Diocese of Leeds) for all their hard work, help and expertise. Fingers crossed that we now have solved all the problems and are alright for a few more years. Thank you very much. K. C.
