Friday is the feast of St Luke. There is a legend that Luke was a skilled painter and had the unique distinction of being the only New Testament writer who was not a Jew. He was a doctor by profession and maybe that gave him the wide sympathy he possessed. The symbol of Luke is a calf which is the animal for sacrifice. Luke saw in Jesus the sacrifice for all the world. In Luke above all the barriers are broken down and Jesus is for Jew and gentile, saint and sinner. As the trusted companion of Paul on some of his travels he must have known many of the leading figures of the Church and from them he must have learnt much about the life of Jesus which he was about to write for the Gentile readers.
