Cardinal Arthur Roche was ordained for the Diocese of Leeds by Bishop Gordan Wheeler in 1975, as was Bishop Moger, seven years later in 1982. Archbishop John Wilson was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop David Konstant in 1993. **On 21<sup>st</sup> February Bishop Moger was ordained a Bishop at St George's Cathedral, Southwark by Archbishop Wilson in the presence of Cardinal Roche. All from the Leeds Diocese.**
