PASCHAL CANDLE



Thank you, Fr Nealon, for polishing the Paschal Candle in preparation for our celebration of the Risen Christ. Our Paschal Candle is a bit of a mystery. It is engraved at the base indicating that it was presented to Rev. A.J. Saxton by the Catholics of Otley on the occasion of his Silver Jubilee. September 8th 1915. Canon Austin J Saxton died on 11th August 1927. St Theresa's only opened on 18th November 1931 but we didn't have a resident Parish Priest until 1948. Hopefully my response from Archives department at the Diocese will throw some light on our Paschal Candle. (No pun intended)

If anybody can offer any information about the Paschal Candle please let me know.
