leaders who will facilitate discussion about the future of the Church. **Points to consider:**

1. Who are we on the journey with and what persons or groups are marginalised and why?
2. How might the Church better listen to lay people, especially young people and women and minorities and those not respected?
3. How can everybody be encouraged to communicate appropriately what is important to them?
4. How might we better able to participate in Mass and other liturgies?
5. How can each baptized person become a "missionary disciple"?
6. How might we improve our conversations within our Diocesan Family and with other faiths?
7. Are our relations with our Christian brothers and sisters good? How might they be improved?
8. How might we develop teamwork and a sense of co-responsibility in the Church?
9. How might we improve the process of decision making in our local Church so that we truly listen and recognize that the Holy Spirit can speak through each of us?
10. What formation is necessary within the local Church if we are to become better at listening to one another and sharing our insights with one another.
