Last weekend Fr Bob made the difficult decision to temporarily close our Church due to the current health risks.

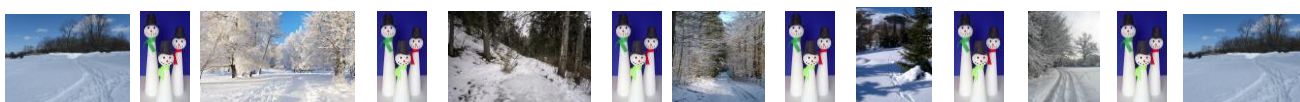
