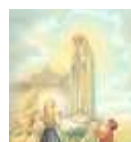

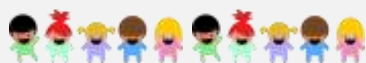

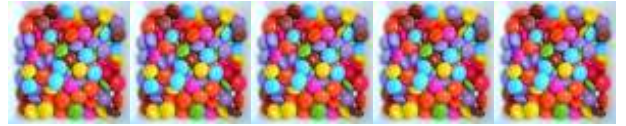


## YOUR PARISH NEEDS YOU
