The New Normal:

Rev. Canon Philip Fitzgerald died on Sunday 9th August. Please pray for the repose of his soul and remember his family in your prayers. He was ordained in Tipperary in 1968 and has served the Leeds Diocese for over 50 years. Fr Phil was Parish Priest for St Malachy's from 1989 until 1999. He moved to St Joseph's in Brighouse in 2005 as Parish Priest where he had also served as curate from 1979 to 1984. Fr Phil celebrated his Golden Jubilee in 2018. It was in the following year that ill health resulted in Canon Fitzgerald's early retirement from active ministry and he chose to continue living in Brighouse. He will be sadly missed. RIP Fr. Fitz
