THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY – 15th AUGUST



Father, Mary was full of grace at all times, from the beginning of her life to the last moment. May she be with us at every moment of our lives: in the calm moments when our lives flow along like a singing brook or a gurgling stream: and in the troubled moments when our lives are full of turbulence. May she be with us now and at the hour of our death, so that moment may become the moment of our glory. We ask this through Christ Our Lord.

Friday 20th August - Mass at 12noon for the feast of St Bernard at Fountains Abbey.

Saints of the week:

16th August – Saint Stephen of Hungary – born about 969 he was crowned King of Hungary in 1000. Stephen ruled wisely. He was peaceful and religious and was dedicated to spreading Christianity, establishing dioceses and strengthening the life of the Church. He died in 1038.

19th August – Saint John Eudes – born in France in 1601. He became a priest and a Missionary, travelling to many parishes in France. He promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart and founded a congregation to promote the formation of priests. He also founded the Congregation of Our Lady of Refuge to rescue women and girls trying to escape from a life of prostitution. He died in 1680.

20th August – St Bernard – born near Dijon in France in 1090. Bernard entered the Cistercian Order at 22; he became the Abbott of Clairvaux. He travelled a great deal in France, Germany and Italy, trying to reconcile the divisions of the Church of the time. He wrote many works on the spiritual life and theology.

21st August – St Pious X – Joseph Sarto was born in Riese, Italy into a poor family in 1835. He became Patriarch of Venice in 1893 and Pope in 1903. He sought to renew Christian life by emphasizing the Eucharist. He worked strenuously to avoid war in 1914 but died shortly after its outbreak on 20th August.
